

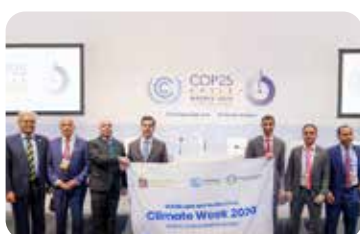
WGEO at COP25 December 2019
